The original parsonage was just to the east of the 1926 sanctuary. It was cleared to make room for the new sanctuary and fellowship hall, built in the 1960's. The current parsonage is located across the street from the church, at 2 Signal Hill Boulevard.



The cornerstone for the new sanctuary and fellowship hall was laid in 1965. A service of consecration was held on Sunday, January 22, 1967, with Bishop Lance Webb presiding. The title of his sermon was "When the Church is Beautiful and Enduring."
